An introduction to me and what is important to me...

My first language, my personality, my favourite things, likes and dislikes, current interests, hobbies/outside the setting activities, allergies/medical information

At home I speak Polish with my family and am beginning to use some English words. I am confident at home but in new situations I am very shy and need a little bit of time to settle. I can find it scary to talk with adults I don't yet know. I have a special teddy that I take everywhere with me. My teddy makes me feel safe. At home I laugh a lot and like to play tricks on my family. I am very curious and like to explore outside in the park looking for worms and butterflies with my brother. I also like to play mummies and babies with my doll and dressing up in my mummy's shoes. I don't like loud noises and thunderstorms scare me. My dad is teaching me how to ride my bike. I love swimming with my family and I have swimming lessons once a week. I am allergic to dairy produce as it triggers my eczema. I have special cream for when my eczema is sore.

Who is important to me and my home life...

Parents, carers, siblings, grandparents, aunts and uncles and family friends that are regularly involved in the day to day care. If the child attends another setting or a childminder include the details. Where I live and information about my family including any support they are receiving.

I live with my mum, dad, older brother (8), my baby sister (11 months) and my grandmother. Our home can be quite busy at times! The rest of my family live in Poland and we always talk to them on the computer. I love playing with my baby sister, singing songs and reading her stories. I like chasing my brother in the park and going on the slide with him. I live in a flat and share a room with my brother. I have been going to Nursery (Insert Name) school every morning since I was three years old and really enjoy it. I have delayed social and communication skills so sometimes find it hard to express myself. Visual clues help me express myself more effectively.

I like to take on a role in my play especially pretending to be mummy or a teacher. I have lots of ideas and make links to my home life when I play. Sometimes I copy what other children do but mostly I like to use my own ideas. I am confident to select resources around the room to use in my play.

Documents to be attached recent assessments, support plans, health/medical information or reports etc.

I like to watch before I join other children in their play. When an activity gets tricky I will keep trying but sometimes I will stop if it gets too hard and play with something else.

If you ask me about my creations, I will tell you. I can concentrate for long stretches of time when I'm involved with self-chosen activities, especially when I am outside or in the home corner. Sometimes when I am busy playing I forget to go to the toilet so please remind me to go.

I can be shy and will sometimes need adults to encourage me to have a go at new experiences. I like playing on my own but am happy if one or two other children join my play.

I can find change and new routines tricky and will need support from my special adults to support me. A visual timetable will help me with knowing what changes to expect. Loud noises can scare me. If I am feeling frightened, I like cuddles and a calm adult to distract me with a story until I am feeling confident again.
