
How can a PEP be reviewed?



Level 3

At least one of the following applies:

There is **significant** concern about:

- The level of support at school
- The young person's progress or attainment
- The stability of the home or school placement
- The behaviour or emotional needs of the young person
- Exclusion or risk of exclusion from school

Level 2

At least one of the following applies:

Young Person:

- Had a PEP meeting over six months ago
- Is not progressing well
- Has low attainment
- Has high attainment but is not meeting their educational targets
- Is unsettled at home or school
- Has had a change of home or school placement since the last PEP meeting

Level 1

All of the following applies:

Young Person:

- Had a PEP meeting up to six months ago
- Is progressing well
- Is settled at home
- Is well supported at school
- Has not had a change of school or home placement since the last PEP meeting
