Coronavirus Early years



Please remember - To avoid spread of infection, always:

Minimise contact and mixing – try to keep 2m apart



Clean surfaces regularly e.g doors, switches



Wash hands frequently (for at least 20 seconds)



Avoid touching mouth, nose and eyes



What to do if someone develops COVID symptoms?

- Arrange immediate collection so child can self-isolate for 7 days
- If child awaiting collection, move to a separate room with window open
- PPE to be worn by staff member if unable to maintain 2m distance
- Advise to book COVID-19 test asap
- Other children and staff continue to attend setting as normal, unless develop symptoms themselves

What to do if someone else develops COVID symptoms within 14 days (ie a cluster in a bubble?)

- -Follow guidance as before
- -Call health protection team (LCRC) for further guidance and risk assessment

What to do if informed of confirmed case of COVID?

- Call health protection team (LCRC) for advice if not already in contact
- All children / staff in the bubble of the case to self-isolate for 14 days
