- a list or bag of cards with ideas (examples listed on sheet)



Have a list of challenges for children to complete. These could be on cards in a bag so that they can take turns to select one. Discuss ideas in a group and then children go over to the place or objects.

Ideas for challenges

Hug something bigger than you

Run to something that is bigger than me

Point at something bigger than a car

Hold something that is small

Squeeze something that is very small

Stand next to something that is very, very big

Do a silly dance next to something very big

Put something small in your pocket

Put three things in a row

Make a face picture with small things

Pretend to pick up something that is very, very big

Stand next to something the same size as you
