You will need:

- paper
- suitable leaves (no prickles or irritating sap)
- wax crayons





How to do a leaf rubbing

Collect some leaves that are different shapes.

Lay the leaf on a flat surface with the leaf veins (bumpy side) facing upwards and put a piece of scrap paper on top.

While holding the paper still, rub a crayon sideways over the leaf (you'll need to press hard).

Reposition your leaf, put the paper back in the same place and do another leaf rubbing.

Can you make a repeating pattern?
