

SENSORY ACTIVITIES

Use your 5 senses to explore the natural world.

Areas of learning

understanding the world literacy

You will need:

- natural materials, e.g. leaves, sticks, seeds
- nature potions pot: e.g. a yogurt pot
- texture box: egg box with discs in with words written on them, smooth, hard, soft etc.
- sticky card: strip of card with double sided sticky tape on it







Nature sticky cards

Collect different natural materials and attach them to the sticky card. This could be lots of different colours.

Tip: only stick part of the leaf or flower onto the card so that it doesn't take up all the space.

Nature potions

Add different smelling natural materials to a small pot and stir with a stick to release the aromas. Invent a name for the potion and write a recipe for it, e.g. add 2 small green leaves, stir 3 times, etc.

Deer ears

Cup hands behind ears to help you hear like a deer. How many different sounds can you hear?

Why do deer need to have such excellent hearing?

Texture boxes

Find a natural material to go into each section of the texture egg box. Each item needs to be small enough to fit inside it.

Alternatively, draw a grid onto the ground using chalk for children to put their natural materials into.
