1.0 Introduction

30 percent of all 2 year olds in Waltham Forest can get up to 15 hours a week of free Early Learning and Childcare. You are eligible for the funding if you meet <u>certain criteria</u>.

2.0 Create an Account

In order to apply for the 15 hours of Free Childcare and Early learning for 2 year olds, you will first need to create an account.



2 Year Old Eligibility Check

You must be signed in as a Parent/Carer user in order to perform a 2 Year Old eligibility check. Please sign in or sign up for a new account to continue.

Please note that you can only use an email address once to create an account. If you have already created an account and applied before for another child, please use the same account this time. If you do not remember your password, click on the "Forgot Password" section in the sign in page area.

Note for childcare providers

Since one email address can be used only once for a parent portal account, you cannot check the families' eligibility for the 2 YO funding yourself with your setting's email address. For example, you cannot use <u>tinybees@gmail.com</u> for various accounts as the email address can only be used once. Therefore, if a family needs help applying for the funding, you would need



to use the parents/carers email address and apply with the parent/carer present (email verification required for creating an account).

2.1 Account verification

Once you have clicked on "Create", you will receive an Account Verification email as shown below. Please allow few minutes to receive it. If you have not received the email, please check your Spam folder.





Once you have clicked on the link in the account verification email, you can then sign in the parent portal with the password you have chosen.

4.0 Non-financial Criteria

If you meet any of the **non-financial criteria** stated below, please attach proof of your eligibility by uploading a document (e.g. adoption order, DLA letter).

If you're a non-EEA citizen who cannot claim benefits

Your 2-year-old may get free childcare if you are getting <u>support under the Immigration and</u> <u>Asylum Act</u> and have either:

- <u>claimed asylum</u> in the UK and are waiting for a decision (known as 'part 6')
- been refused asylum in the UK (known as 'section 4')

A 2-year-old you care for may also get free childcare if your household income **is £15,400** a year or less after tax, and **you** have either:

leave to remain with 'no recourse to public funds' on <u>family or private life grounds</u>



 the right to live in the UK because you're the main carer of a British citizen (known as a <u>'Zambrano Carer'</u>)

Your 2 -year-old can also get free childcare and early education if they:

- have an education, health and care plan (EHC Plan)
- get Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
- are looked after by a local authority in England or Wales ('in care')
- have left care under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order in England or Wales
