

# **Waltham Forest Early Years Parent Portal**

User guide for applying for 15 hours Free  
Early Learning and Childcare for 2year olds

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## 1.0 Introduction

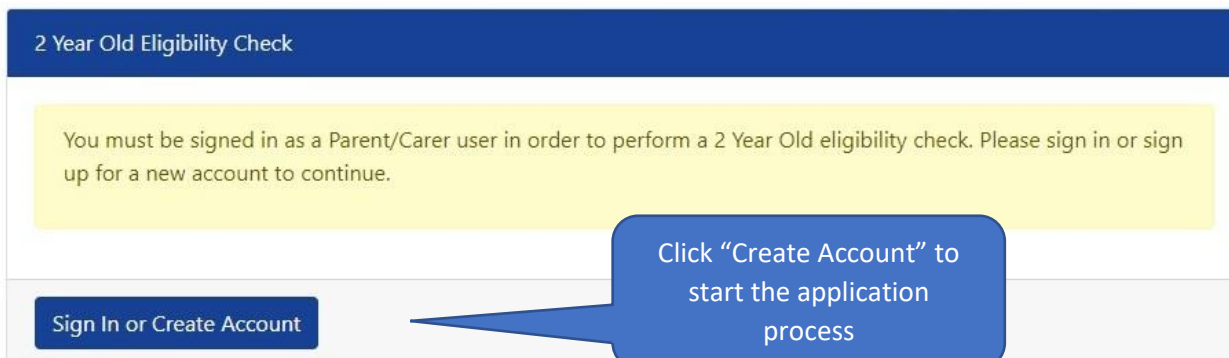
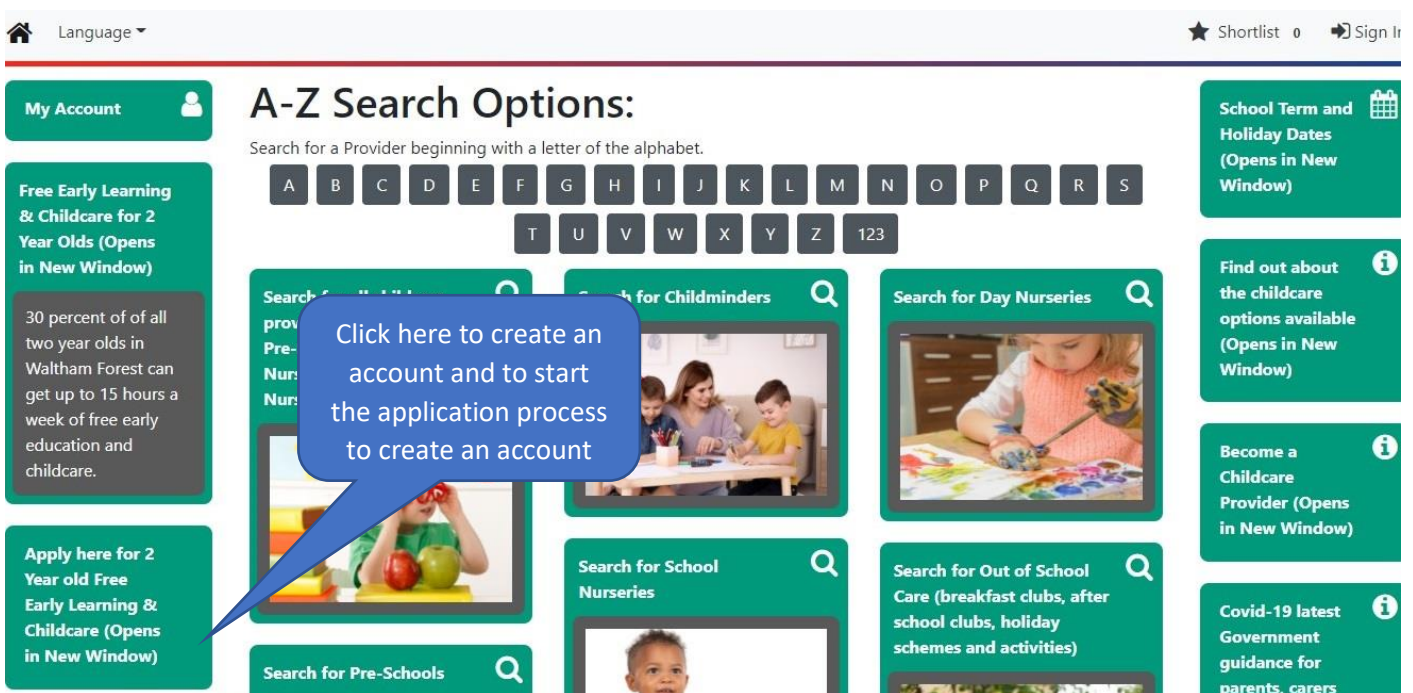
30 percent of all 2 year olds in Waltham Forest can get up to 15 hours a week of free Early Learning and Childcare. You are eligible for the funding if you meet [certain criteria](#).

## 2.0 Create an Account

In order to apply for the 15 hours of Free Childcare and Early learning for 2 year olds, you will first need to create an account.



Once you click on “Sign in or Create Account” the following box appears.

**Please note that you can only use an email address once to create an account.** If you have already created an account and applied before for another child, please use the same account this time. If you do not remember your password, click on the “Forgot Password” section in the sign in page area.

### Note for childcare providers

Since one email address can be used only once for a parent portal account, you cannot check the families’ eligibility for the 2 YO funding yourself with your setting’s email address. For example, you cannot use [tinybees@gmail.com](mailto:tinybees@gmail.com) for various accounts as the email address can only be used once. Therefore, if a family needs help applying for the funding, you would need

to use the parents/carers email address and apply with the parent/carer present (email verification required for creating an account).

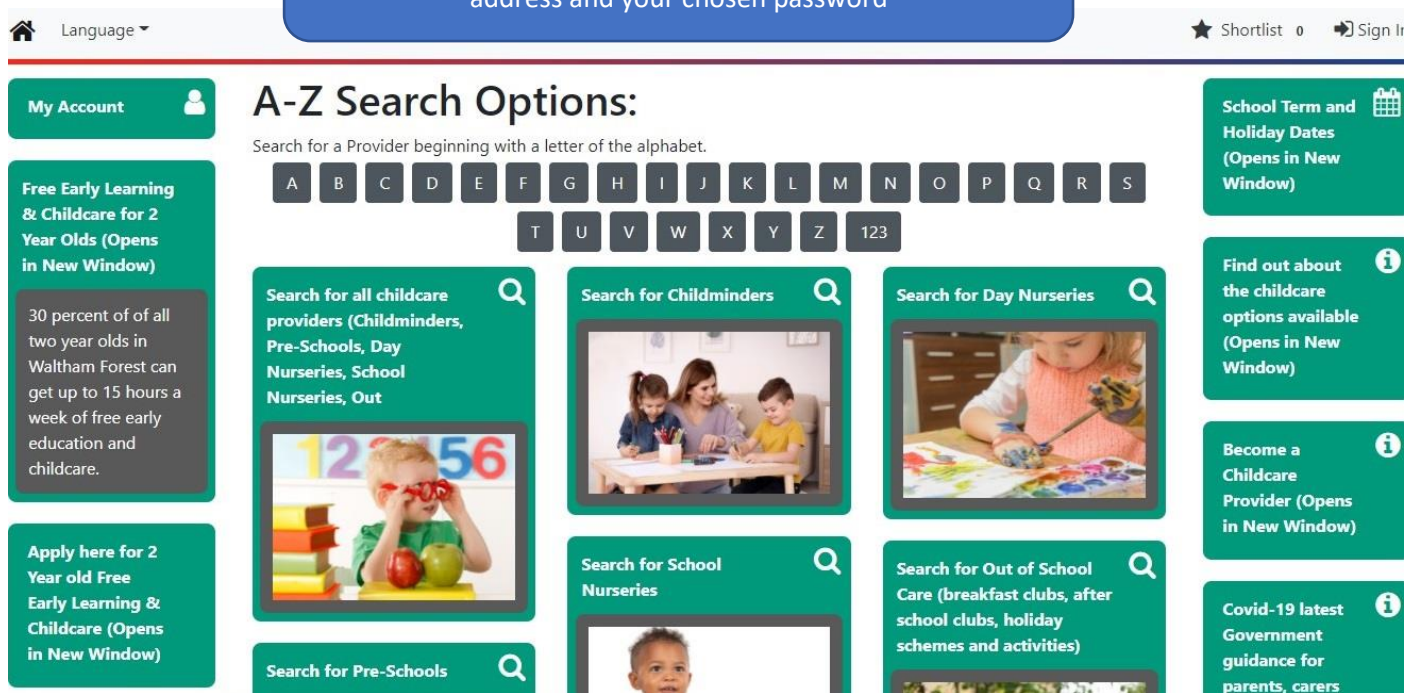

### 3.0 Early Years Application

Once you are signed in, you will need to fill in your details and your child's details to apply for the 15 hours Free Childcare & Early Learning for 2year olds.

### 4.0 Non-financial Criteria

If you meet any of the **non-financial criteria** stated below, please attach proof of your eligibility by uploading a document (e.g. adoption order, DLA letter).

#### If you're a non-EEA citizen who cannot claim benefits

Your 2-year-old may get free childcare if you are getting [support under the Immigration and Asylum Act](#) and have either:

- [claimed asylum](#) in the UK and are waiting for a decision (known as 'part 6')
- been refused asylum in the UK (known as 'section 4')

A 2-year-old you care for may also get free childcare if your household income is **£15,400** a year or less after tax, and **you** have either:

- leave to remain with 'no recourse to public funds' on [family or private life grounds](#)

- the right to live in the UK because you're the main carer of a British citizen (known as a ['Zambrano Carer'](#))

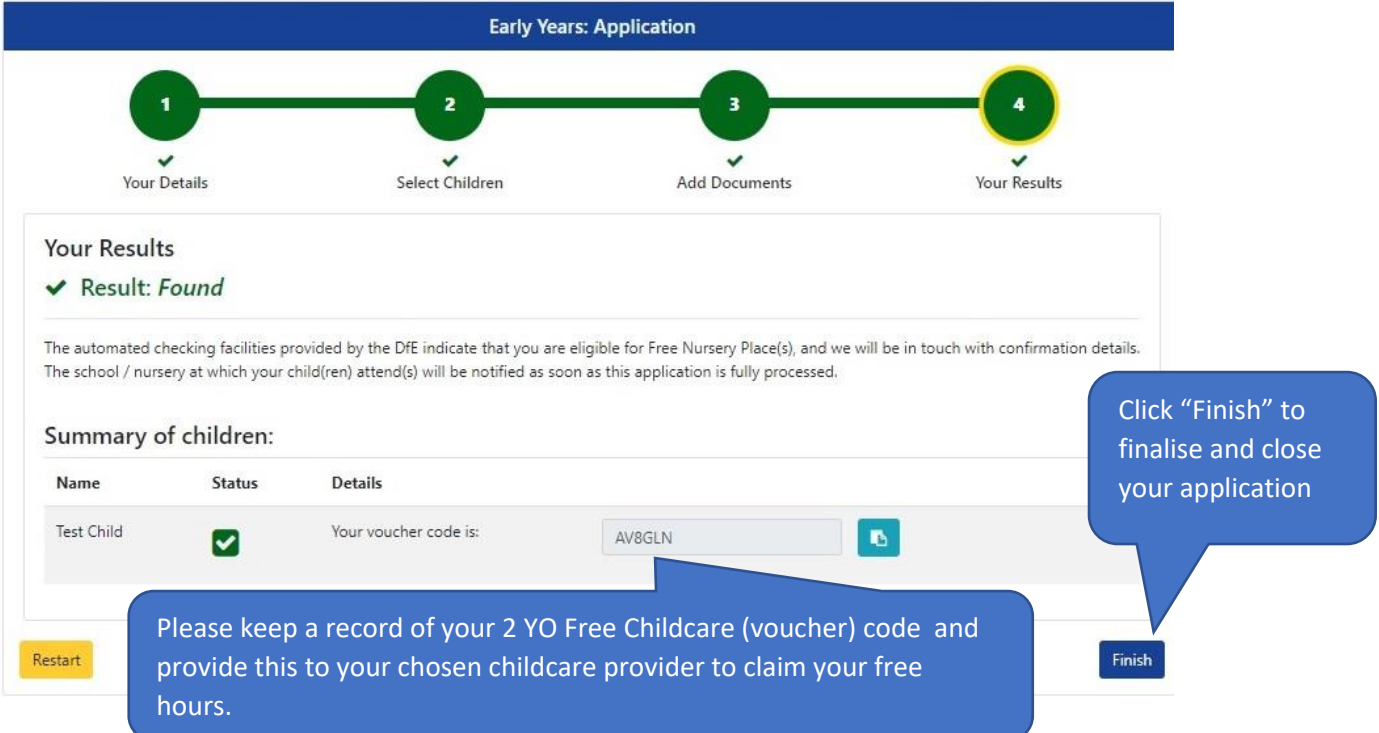
### Your 2 -year-old can also get free childcare and early education if they:

- have an education, health and care plan (EHC Plan)
- get Disability Living Allowance (DLA)
- are looked after by a local authority in England or Wales ('in care')
- have left care under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order in England or Wales

If you meet the non-financial criteria and have uploaded any documents, the Early Years and Childcare Team, will contact you to confirm your eligibility.
