OUR TRAINING APPROACH

Each training subject consists of 3 tiers — we recommend engaging with the tiers in order:



TIER 1

Guidance documents

Read these first for key information and advice about the training subject.

TIER 2

Recorded webinars

Watch these in staff meetings or individually. There are opportunities to pause, reflect, & discuss.

At the end, you will be prompted to create an action plan.

TIER 3

Virtual or In-person sessions

These are opportunities to ask questions & share practical cases with Early Years experts and professionals.

We offer project based trainings e.g. Nurture & Thrive, Being Two, Sing our Story, these run over multiple days, you must attend all the days to receive your certificate.

HOW TO BOOK TRAINING

- 1. Access our online system <u>Traded Services</u>
- 2. Login or sign up
- 3. Book with delegate's full name, email & mobile
- 4. Some trainings are limited to 2 delegates per setting
- 5. Click here for customer guide with pictures

HOW TO PAY

- 1. Costs for fee paying courses & packages are advertised on Traded Services
- 2. You can check-out & pay using Debit/Credit Cards
- 3. ONLY Waltham Forest Schools, Nurseries & Pre-schools can request to pay via invoice at check-out
- 4. Invoices are typically sent in the following calendar month
- 5. Childminding Agencies, Childcare on Domestic Premises Childminders, Proposed Childminders & External Settings MUST pay by card
- 6. Failure to pay invoices will prevent future bookings & outstanding invoices will be sent to debt collection team

AFTER BOOKING TRAINING

- 1. Booking confirmation will be sent via email
- 2. Please check confirmation for your booking status (Confirmed, Waiting List, Awaiting Confirmation)
- Awaiting Confirmation means you'll need to check-out and complete purchase by paying
- 4. Read course information for pre-training guidance documents & webinars
- 5. Training reminders & teams links will be sent 3 days & 1 day before training
- 6. If a generic setting/school email has been used please pass training information on to the delegates

CANCEL & AMEND BOOKINGS

- 1. Contact **EYtraining@walthamforest.gov.uk** for any cancellations or booking amendments
- 2. For **fee paying courses** provide minimum 7 days notice before date of course, to receive a refund
- 3. For **non-fee paying courses** provide at least 3 days notice before date of course

DAY OF TRAINING

- 1. Please arrive 10 mins before to allow for registration
- 2. Delegates arriving 20+ mins late, could be turned away to avoid disruption
